M'ashtra inks pact with Aviation Ministry, AAI for regional air connectivity scheme



Maharashtra Government on Tuesday inked a pact with the Civil Aviation Ministry and AAI for regional connectivity scheme, becoming the first state to formally agree to be part of the Centre's ambitious plan. Under the RCS, around eight airports are expected to be connected in the state.

With the signing of the tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), "Maharashtra has formally agreed to provide the concessions required from the state governments in the RCS, thereby becoming the first state in the country to do so," Civil Aviation Ministry said in a release on Tuesday.

The MoU was signed in presence of Civil Aviation Minister Ashok Gajapati Raju and Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis here. Earlier in the day, Raju said as part of the RCS, the Centre and the state would develop Airports Authority of India (AAI)-owned

When asked about the deadline for operationalising them, Raju said, "I don't set deadlines nor do I work under deadlines. But let's assume at the earliest." "When we announced the RCS, we were speaking

Early operationalisation of several available airports and airstrips in the State (like Shirdi, Kolhapur, Nasik, Sholapur etc) also figured prominently in the discussions," the release said. Raju also undertook an aerial survey of the proposed airport site for Navi Mumbai.

Sensex closes 5 pts higher with gains in IT, PSU, bank shares up

MUMBAI: Bouncing back towards the fag-end of the session in an otherwise choppy trade, the benchmark BSE Sensex on Tuesday closed nearly 5 points higher at 27,990.21 with gains in IT, PSU and banking stocks, tracking a higher opening in the European markets.

However, a mixed trend on Asian bourses amid investors awaiting cues on whether the Federal Reserve would raise US interest rates this year kept investors edgy. Besides, a cautious approach by participants ahead of the August-month expiry in the derivatives segment on Thursday too influenced the domestic trading sentiment. Vinod Nair, Head of Research, Geojit BNP Paribas Financial Services Ltd, said,



"Market remains range-bound with a positive bias due to a slight recovery in European markets. On the other hand, global market is shifting its focus to the possibility of a rate hike in the US by December 2016, which will cast a shadow on the domestic market." PTI

Abiding by association rules, says COAI

Rejecting Reliance Jio's allegations of acting as a mouthpiece of dominant players, cellular operators' body on Tuesday said it has been abiding by the association rules in its communication to the Government on the new entrant's 4G test programme and interconnect issues.

"Where there is no unanimity (on issues), the association bylaws state that majority views have to be expressed. That is what happened in this case. We followed the protocol and noted in our letter that one of our members, RJio, has a minority view, and that they have expressed their views separately on the issue," Rajan S Mathews, Director General, COAI told the news agency.

WHERE THERE IS NO UNANIMITY (ON ISSUES), THE ASSOCIATION BYLAWS STATE THAT MAJORITY VIEWS HAVE TO BE EXPRESSED. THAT IS WHAT HAPPENED IN THIS CASE. WE FOLLOWED THE PROTOCOL AND NOTED IN OUR LETTER THAT ONE OF OUR MEMBERS, RJIO, HAS A MINORITY VIEW, AND THAT THEY HAVE EXPRESSED THEIR VIEWS SEPARATELY ON THE ISSUE, SAYS DG OF COAI RAJAN S MATHEWS

Mathews said COAI's position reflected the majority stance as determined through voting shares that is based on member company's revenue. "Members may feel that it is not appropriate but when they join the association they are informed about the bylaws, and they agree to abide by the bylaws before becoming members," he said.

Asked if the internal strife between existing players and the new operator was enough to split the 6-member association, Mathews said, "No. We don't want the association to break." "Such matters should be discussed fairly and transparently. It is in the spirit of a competitive landscape and clarification is good for the industry. That clarification can only come from DOT and TRAI," Mathews pointed out.
